
Attended by telephone/ video conferencing: Alderman Devaull.

A motion was made by Alderman Allen, seconded by Alderman Haynes to "table" discussion regarding a proposal from Ten One Strategies, LLC for capitol lobbying before the Mississippi Legislature and other advocacy services, in exchange for a flat fee of \$4,000.00 for the remainder of the legislative session. On a roll call vote, all present voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Alderwoman Odom, seconded by Alderman Devaull to retain Daniel L. Wilder, Attorney, Macon, Georgia as a Special Counsel to represent the City of Aberdeen in the Bradberry Logistics & Services, LLC Bankruptcy case pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Middle District of Georgia, Chapter 11, Case No. 21-50923. Bradbury has filed a Motion to assume executory contract against the City of Aberdeen, and the matter is scheduled for a hearing on March 16, 2022. Wilder also represents the Development Authority of Crawford County, Georgia in the bankruptcy case. On a roll call vote, Alderman Devaull, Alderwoman Odom, and Alderman Allen voted "Aye". Alderwoman Garth voted "Nay". Alderman Haynes "abstained".
